External doctorate in technology and innovation management

The Dr. Theo Schöller Endowed Chair of Technology and Innovation Management at the TUM School of Management of the Technical University of Munich, headed by Prof. Dr. Joachim Henkel, offers selected employees of management consultancies the opportunity to do their doctorate during a two-year leave of absence.

During this time, you will be involved on site and in the department, participate in teaching and supervising students, interact with and learn from the other team members, and receive close academic supervision from Prof. Henkel.

The topic of the dissertation is in the field of technology and innovation management and will be jointly determined. We are happy to discuss possible topics upon request or during an initial interview.

The goal of the doctorate is to produce outstanding scientific research with sophisticated methods and high relevance for practice. This should result in joint scientific publications in recognized scientific journals.
