It's the data, stupid? – Understanding the importance of different resources for innovations in Analytics

What is the purpose of the research project?

- It is often claimed, that access to high-quality data is the key component in machine learning. However, at present there is no empirical but only anecdotal evidence for this claim
- The purpose of the research is to understand the importance of different resources for companies relying on machine learning.

How is the research conducted?

- To answer the aforementioned question, interviews with CEO/CTO/VP Engineering of companies that primarily rely on Machine Learning are conducted.
- Further data (e.g. Funding data) is collected from external sources

Who is running this research project?

- This research project is led by Prof. Joachim Henkel, Professor for Technology and Innovation management, and Philipp Hartmann, PhD candidate.
- Both are affiliated with the Dr. Theo Schöller-Chair for Technology- and Innovation Management (https://www.tim.wi.tum.de)

How is the project funded?
